On Sunday the children studied the incredible properties of bird eggs. We tested the strength of egg shells by attempting to crush a raw egg by squeezing it in the palms of our hands (this is practically impossible, but we used a ziplock baggie just in case!) We discussed the importance of the egg shell and the properties that make it difficult to crush from the outside, but possible for a baby chick to peck through.

Then we used hard-boiled eggs to study motion and inertia. Using a glass filled with water, a pie plate and a cardboard tube. We dropped the egg into the glass without touching it — ask your kids for a demonstration of this very cool trick!
