Sexton's Report

Radek reported that he finished painting the door to the parlors and he is almost done with the new porch floor at the parlor entrance. On Gina's suggestion, the committee recommends that Radek receive a bonus of \$150 for doing this extra work.

Old Business

Jack reported that he purchased 1615 gallons of heating oil for the price of \$2.01 per gallon. We still have on our account 385 gallons from last year that were not consumed and for which last years price will apply. Gina reported that tomorrow she will be meeting with Robert Black, the architect, and Tom Havel who will be doing the excavation. The actual work will start the week of July 24th. The understanding is that the funds for the parking lot work will come from the B&G budget and the rest is part from the capital improvement fund.

New Business

We are pleased that the rearranging of the garden, next to the entrance of the social hall, has completely eliminated the mulch run off onto the walk way.

We discussed the painting of the pizza oven and we decided that not only does it need to be finished but also painted a pale gray color to give the appearance of rustic out look. Gina and Deb Rice will do the painting.

It came to Gina's attention that there was a request from a church member to borrow or rent our chairs and tables for an event away from the church. The committee already has a policy that chairs and tables are not allowed to leave the social hall, under any circumstances, so request was denied.

There will be a wedding at the church on July 23rd and since Geraldine will be away Gina suggested that it would be helpful if a committee member is present during the rehearsal, July 22nd at 3:45 pm, in case they have any questions. Jack has agreed to be the one.

Jack also volunteer to put a box on the exterior outlet of the North side of the church. In addition, Jack will talk to the Green Mountain Plumbing and see what can be done with the exposed sink drains in the kitchen.
